








Despite the covid pandemic our renowned institution Sahibzada Ajit Singh Academy left no stone unturned to educated and inspire students to actively participate in the eco club and activities through virtual media.

The following activities and discussion were carried out by our Institution in the academic year 2020-21 for awareness and imparting education and knowledge to the students as well as to the masses through informational videos, posters etc. on the occasions.

- 1. We tried to create awareness through poster etc. on world water day.
- 2. In addition to it, an oath taking ceremony was also carried out on World Environment Day.
- 3. All the club members worked out on a photo collage to give away their gratitude to the medical staff to appreciate their efforts and tremendous dedication they gave to safeguard the lives of the people affected during Covid pandemic.
- 4. We also organized competition on the occasion of World Earth Day and tried to cover approved days related to environment using social media.
- 5. Our students also made campus plastic free zone by eliminating the consumption of use of plastic and adapting the alternative for the same.
- 6. Furthermore, the school also decided to go digital by minimizing the use of paper and promoting E-exams, E-result etc.
- 7. Also, our student anticipated in Swacch Bharat Abhiyan and cleared all the litter from the locality and school and kept dustbin to dump recyclable and non-recyclable waste separately
- Lastly, school also decided to collect and decompose bio degradable waste and convert into compost that can be utilized for growing green cover around the campus.

It is undeniable fact that PTA continues to be strong pillar and support for smooth functioning of the school. Along with Teachers and Management, and support of the parents and guardians, key emphasis is laid on the fact that effective relationship and communication between staff, parents and other associated with the Institution is carried out for the overall development of the children. In order to achieve so, we leave no stone unturned to satisfy the queries of the parents and the children, thereby ensuring effective functioning of the institution. The key aspects discussed in the PTA are as under:

- 1. It was resolved that school will charge Annual Fee and other expenses only as per the instruction given by the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India, and parents gave affirmation for the same. However, if any parent find difficult to pay the fee, exemption in fee are made according to the problems faced by the individual.
- 2. In addition to it, no hike in fee is made for the prevailing session.
- 3. Pitching the next area of discussion, Parents and Management decided to conduct online examination and online classes due to covid-19 situation and suggestion from parents for the same were equally welcomed.
- 4. In context to the above mentioned, parents agreed to keep hawk eye on the students during test and exams so that their actual performance can be reviewed and malpractices like cheating, copying etc. can be avoided.
- 5. As per the suggestion of the parents, PTM was conducted to discuss about the overall performance and drawback of the students.
- 6. Resolved that a virtual PTM was arranged in school prior reopening of the school, as it was inevitable as per Govt. norms. Parents were informed about the safety measures the school proposes for physically reopening of it for students but an undertaking by parents is mandatory before the ward is sent to school.

#### **DECISIONS OF SCHOOL MANAGEMENT COMMITTEE (SMC)**

It is undeniable fact that School Management Committee plays crucial role in actualizing the goals of successful running of this Institution. It has indeed tremendous potential to transform existing system of education, characterized by cynicism and defeatist outlook of the system functionaries and stake holders.

Despite the outbreak of Covid 19 pandemic, committee decided to strictly adhere to the guidelines issues by Govt. to combat the prevailing situation that devastated the whole scenario of regular classes.

- It aimed at providing online classes so that distance should not be a hindrance in learning. In order to achieve so wifi, lecture stands, holders are provided to each and every teacher.
- 2. It laid SOP for covid prevention are followed. strenuous impahasis on the safety of the teaching and non-teaching staff and thereby proper sanitization is carried out on regular basis. In addition to it, sanitizers and disinfectants are provided in each and every corner of campus to attain a sterile environment for its staff.
- It will work according to specific directions laid for admission policy and new admissions will be made as per merit without discretion of caste, creed, religion and region.
- 4. It will also take in consideration that buildings are strictly adhered to the safety norms and stock requirements of lab, library etc. are updated for smooth functioning when school physically reopen for students.
- 5. Lastly, recruitment of new staff was carried out as per the norms laid by CBSE so that lack of skilled professionals do not hinder the education of students.

#### RESULT

Annual Examination for session 2020-21 is successfully completed in the month of March 2021 with the support of staff members and under able leadership of Mr. Principal and Madam Vice-Principal. Pass percentage of students from grade Nursery to VIII is 100%. They all passed and they promoted to the next grade. In the same in grade IX 155 students appeared in both online and offline mode examination. They passed and promoted to next grade X. In grade XI 134 students appeared in examination, they passed the examination and promoted to the next class.
